Christiana Township and Oakland Township each donated \$30,000 for the purchase of the new radios. The balance of cost after \$60,000 will be supplemented by grant money and commission budget. Gene Kapsner raised the issue if the Friends of EMS had been asked to donate toward the radio purchase. Friends of EMS have asked for more information before committing to the donation.

Defibrillator: EMS is in need of two new defibrillators. Management team is writing grants and if one defibrillator is purchased with grant money or budget money, a second defibrillator will be donated by an anonymous donor.
